

**Activity:**

A soundscape to listen to

Duration:

10 minutes

Resources:

1 sound clip which can be paused and replayed to clarify and discuss what has been heard.

A printable PDF of photos to talk about, if further prompts are required.

Extras:

Note book or recording device to share stories about cinemas and evenings out.

Activity aim:

- To listen to a variety of sound clips and stories which describe a visit to the cinema.
- To recall stories about cinemas people visited and what sort of films they like to watch.

Instructions:

1. Be still and quiet for a minute and listen to the sounds around you.
2. Explain that you are going to listen to some short sound recordings which describe a trip to the cinema.
3. Play the sound clip, pausing and replaying as appropriate. At the end, look at the photos and talk about cinemas, films and evenings out.

Topics for discussion:

- What is your favourite film?
- Who did you go to the cinema with? Who do you like watching films with?
- Who are your favourite comedy characters? Can you do an impression of them?
- Do you like dressing up to go out? What do you do to get ready?
- What do you like to eat and drink at the pictures?
- What other entertainment was there on a Saturday night?
