	Activity:	Memories of the severe winter of 1947
	Duration:	10 minutes
	Resources:	A collection of recordings which include sound effects and spoken word. A printable PDF of photos to talk about, if further prompts are required.
	Extras:	Notebook or recording device to share stories about the winter of 1947 or other severe weather experiences.

**Activity Information Sheet:** 

## Activity aim:

- To listen to a montage of sound clips and stories which describe the extreme weather conditions of 1947's winter.
- To recall stories about winter weather and the effects it has on day to day life.

## Instructions:

- 1. Be still and quiet for a minute and listen to the sounds around you.
- 2. Explain that you are going to listen to some short sound recordings about people's experience of the extreme weather in the winter of 1947.
- 3. Look at the photos from 1947 showing the snow in a town and in the countryside. Play the sound clip and be prepared to pause and rewind if you need to listen to sections again. There are sound effects of a snowstorm between each speaker to mark suitable places to pause.

## **Topics for discussion:**

- Was there ever a time when you were snowed in?
- What's the most extreme weather you have ever experienced?
- What would you say are the best ways of keeping warm in winter?
- Have you ever done something heroic for your family or community?
